Recommendations of the Special Management Committee meeting held on Tuesday 11 May 2021 are as follows:-

5.1 Consideration of the capital estimates and operating estimates for revenue and expenditure for the 2021/2022 financial year

#### Resolved to Recommend:

That, subject to the conditions of section 83(1) of the Local Authorities Act, 1992, the Municipal Council of Walvis Bay adopts for subsequent approval by the Minister:

- 1. The total Capital Project estimates amounting to N\$ 588,939,097.
- 2. The anticipated spending for Capital estimates for the 2021/2022 financial year amounting to N\$ 276,114,097.
- 3. The Operating Budget (Expenditure) for the 2021/2022 financial year amounting to N\$ 758,696,191.
- 4. The Operating Budget (Income) for the 2021/2022 financial year amounting to N\$ 758,696,191.

### 5.2 Consideration of the tariffs for the 2021/2022 financial year

#### Resolved to Recommend:

That the tariffs for the 2021/2022 financial year for all operating services as set out in the attached schedule, be adopted by Municipal Council under section 30(1)(u) of the Local Authorities Act, 1992 (Act No. 23 of 1992), to become effective from the date that it is published in the Government Gazette.
